 "Inflexible time of day training"		Teachers arrive to teach as early as 6am
 "TasTAFE has the lowest teaching hours"		Teachers work more hours per year than NSW and ACT
 "Unable to adapt to shifting employer demands"		Government mismanagement and underfunding restricts teacher options
 "Need micro-credentials/-skill-sets"		Already in place: 'Skill Up' short courses for COVID-19 recovery
 "Courses offered are too-broad"		Standards and content are developed by industry nationally
 "Amending the TasTAFE-Award ... would not achieve change at the pace required"		Negotiations are due to finish 30 June 2021
 "TasTAFE is not being privatised"		The plan involves: Full cost recovery and profit objective. More public money to private training companies. Teachers dumped into private sector
